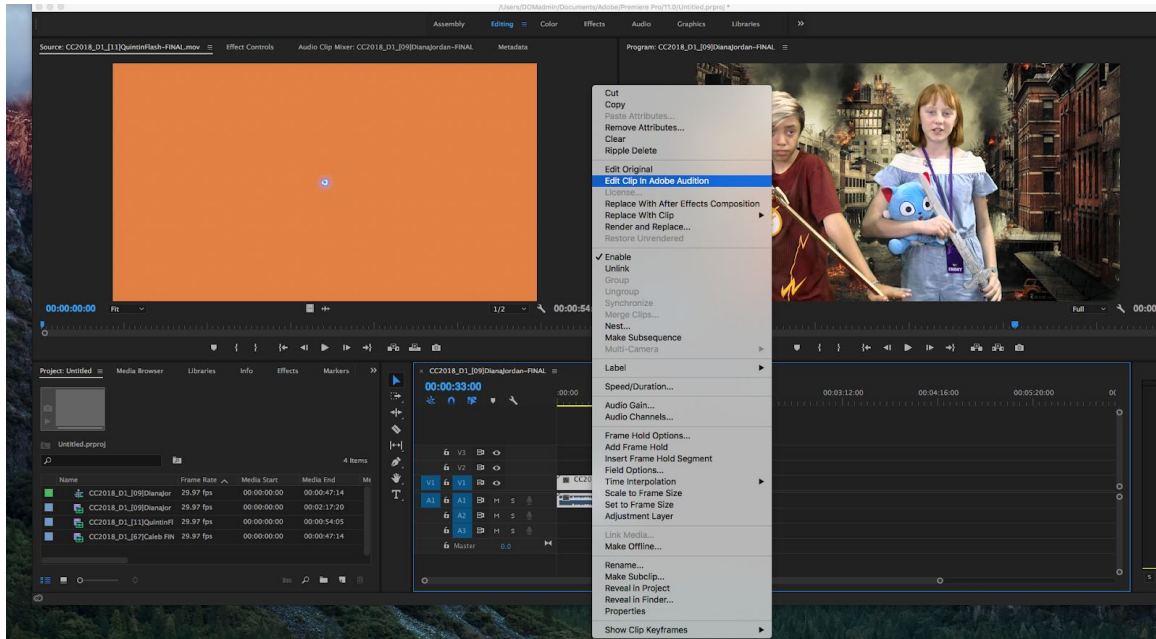
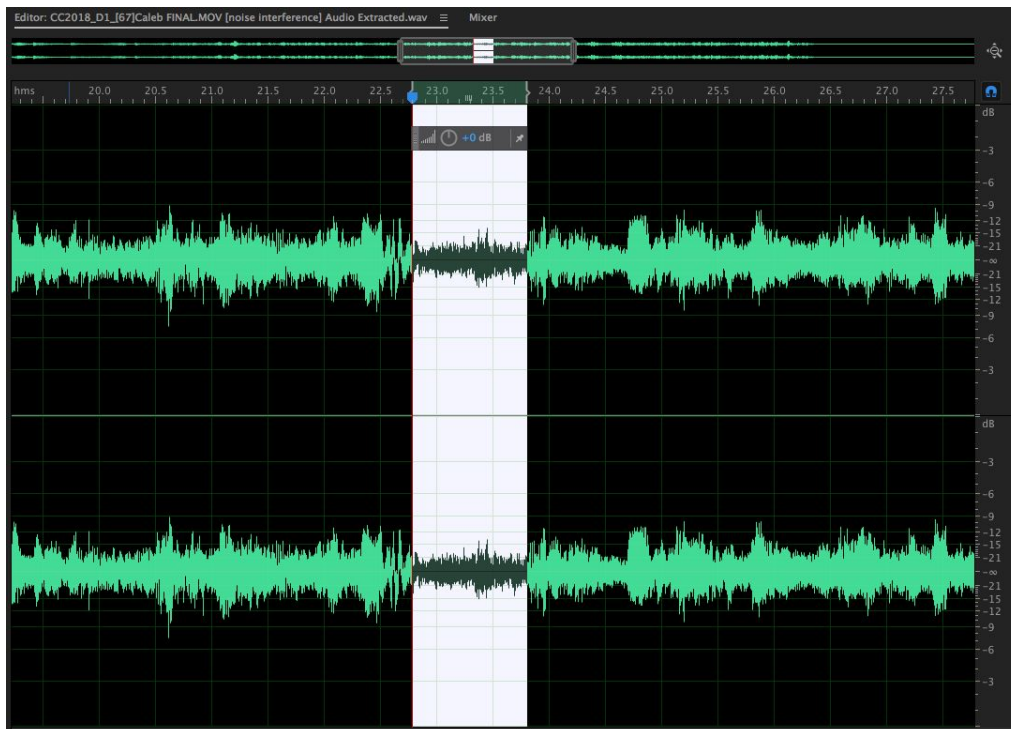


This is a quick guide to fix excessive noise issues in your videos. If you have any questions, email dom@openmediafoundation.org

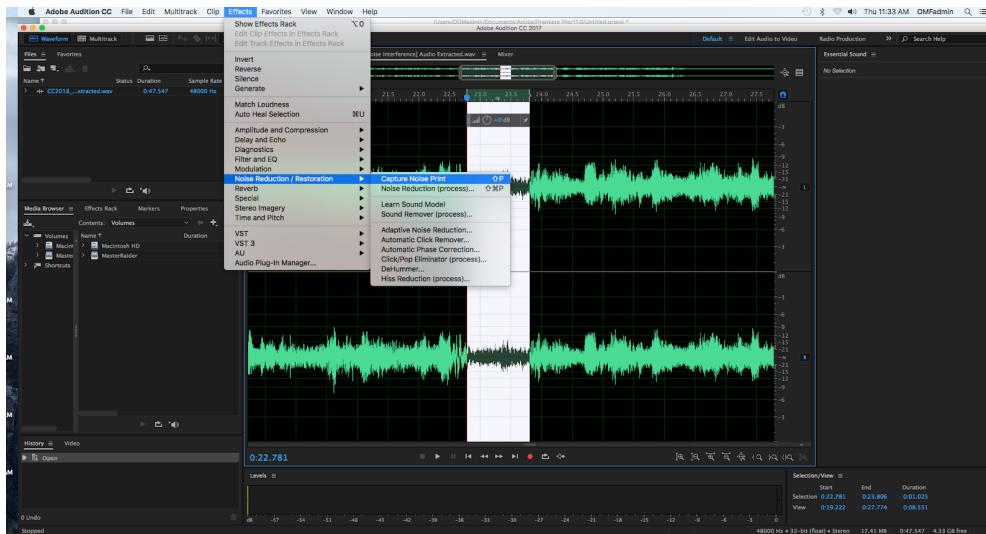
Step 1: Right click on the audio track of the clip, and select “Edit Clip in Adobe Audition”. This will send the clip to Adobe Audition to be edited.



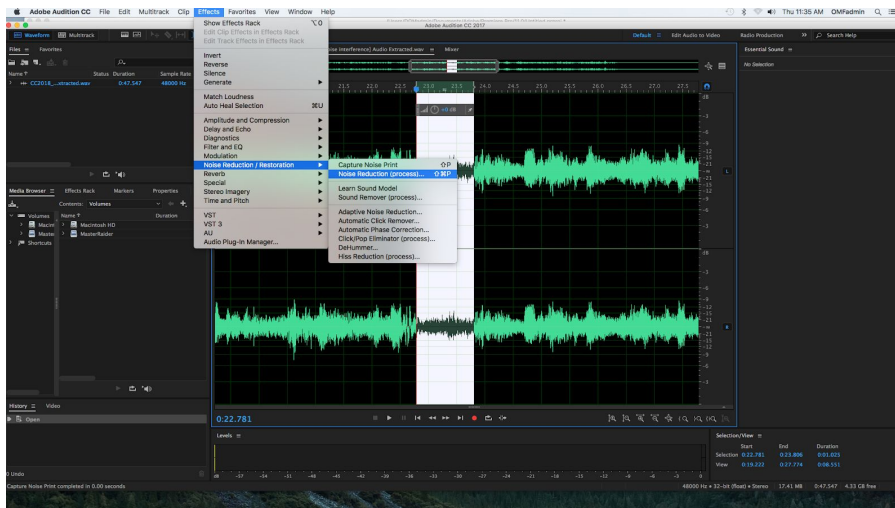
Step 2: Try and find a 2-3 second section where the main actors aren't speaking, and it is only the background/ambient noise you want to reduce. Highlight the section.



Step 3: Go to Effects>Noise Reduction/Restoration> Capture Noise Print and hit “OK”



Step 4: Go to Effects>Noise Reduction/Restoration>Noise Reduction (Process)



BCH: You can then test the difference between using the noise reduction and not using it by hitting the power button in the bottom left corner and playing the track. Depending on how it sounds, you might want to increase how much noise is reduced by increasing the noise reduction percentage. **6 YWUFYZ `k\ Yb`Xc]b[`h]g`h ci [\ `**If you do it too much, it will sound tinny and hollow. Only do as much as you need. You want the end result to make the voices audible and clear enough to hear without distorting the background too much.
